Pioneer of the Year 2024

The membership of the Marysville Historical Society is proud to award the 2024 Pioneer of the Year Award to MSH President Peter Condyles. In the tradition of the old Pioneer Association that merged with the Marysville Historical Society in 1997, individuals are selected as people who have made a difference in the Marysville Community. It is a long overdue honor that MHS presents the 2024 award to President Condyles.

Lobby Display Case: Steve Edin, Peter Condyles, and Tom King set up a new display in the front lobby case. The theme is Marysville's service clubs. Most of the service clubs represented in the case are now defunct. The World War One Veterans Organization, the Arts Guild, the Kiwanis Club, the Log Cabin Club, the Lions Club, and the Kellogg March Garden Club are represented.

1890s Marysville Globes: President Condyles reported that the Board approved spending up to two thousand dollars to digitize more Marysville Globe editions. The paperwork has been completed and turned in for processing.

Financial Matters: The museum's mortgage has been officially paid off. MHS now has a savings account and two checking accounts. One checking account was used to make the monthly mortgage payments. Without the loan, there is no further need for a second checking account. The Board has voted to close the loan account and consolidate all funds into one checking account and one savings account. The Board has approved moving about \$50,000 from the checking account to a savings account, which will be touched for now. The plan is to turn the savings account into an endowment investment fund. The Board is working with Steve Muller to determine what that will look like. MHS will have about \$25,000 left in the checking account.

New Business

Mortgage Burning Party: President Condyles announced the official MHS mortgage burning party on February 16th, 2025.

Grove Church: The Grove Street Church will no longer rent the museum facility on Tuesday nights beginning January 2025.
